Dear St Mary & Assumption Parishioners,

Merry Christmas! I love that liturgically the celebration of Christmas is much more than what secular society celebrates. By December 26th they have moved on, but for us in the Church, we are just beginning our celebration! This is because we celebrate Christmas for an octave, 8 days concluding with the Solemnity of Mary the Mother of God. It's as if there is too much to celebrate that we cannot fit into just one day, and not even into one week either!

Octaves for celebrations in the Church developed over time and really did not become a more constant thing until the eighth century, but they did not come from out of thin air. There are many Jewish festivals and events from the Old Testament which took place over eight days highlighting the significance of what they were celebrating. Here we can see how that spirit of celebrating from our Jewish brothers and sisters have informed our celebrating significant celebrations in a big way. May we live in this spirit of celebrating Christmas throughout the whole octave. Who doesn't love the idea of Christmas eight days in a row?!

Spiphany Blessing
been a tradition in the Catholic Church to bless chalk at the Mass

for Epiphany, and then use the blessed chalk as part of blessing one's home in the New Year.

- Using the blessed chalk, mark the current year and the initials of the Maji above the outside doorways of your home. Place a cross between each of the letters. It should look something like this: XX+C+M+B+XXV or 20+C+M+B+25
- After completing the above markings, pray the following prayer:
 May all who come to our home this year rejoice to find Christ living among us; and may we seek and serve, in everyone we meet, that same Jesus who is Lord of all people, forever and ever.
 Amen.
- The legendary names of the three Magi are: Casper, Melchior, and Balthasar. The initials C+M+B also stand for the Latin words, "Christus Mansionem Benedicat" which means: "May Christ bless this dwelling."
- The markings over the doors should be left all year round as a sign that yours is a Christian home.
