

### Pastor's Corner

Dear St. Mary's Parishioners,

Today we celebrate the Solemnity of the Sacred Heart of Jesus and tomorrow the Immaculate Heart of Mary. Two exceptionally beautiful celebrations. On Sunday, we are back to the 10<sup>th</sup> Sunday in Ordinary Time. I just had Mass at the Court, anointed someone at the Villa, visited six people at the Hospital and took Holy Communion to eleven people at their homes. My observation is that we have a lot of very devout elderly and wonderful care givers in David City. God bless

If you know of someone who would like a priest to visit, please let us know. We recently had someone die in David City, whom we did not know was elderly and unable to attend Mass and so we did not take them Communion (until a hospital visit). Granted, most of the USA would not have such opportunities as we offer in our Diocese and David City, but we might as well enjoy the good services we offer, while we can. We are here to serve you.

On the financial side of things, we are coming to the end of our fiscal year on June 30, 2024. Currently we are about four weeks behind in our Sunday collection (total of \$71,500). We have \$15K in the bank. We are managing due to a major gift from the late Phyllis Lukassen, thanks be to God. I would prefer to not spend from that gift. We have several capital improvement projects taking place in the next few months. We will have our asphalt parking lot seal coated for \$14,500 next week. Within a month, we will have our five stairway entrances to the Church coated with a beautiful and durable (polyaspartic) coating costing \$10,527. Soon after and coordinated along with, we will have new railings installed around the church for \$18,190 with the Butler County Area Foundation donating \$5,000 and Timpte donating \$7K in material. Each of these capital improvement projects is needed to care of our Church and grounds.

Any gift you can give would be appreciated. You can give directly to St. Mary's or to the projects by making a note. Generally, I try to trust in your good stewardship and tithing. When we committed to these projects, we were not so far behind as we are now. Everyone's financial situation is very different and giving is a very personal act of charity and love. Maybe some can help in our time of need.

I want to thank those who ran for Parish Council and PCCW last week. The voting was very close, and we welcome Dawn Jakub and John Wehrs to the Parish Council. The PCCW welcomes Ashley Kobza and Carly Eller to their officers.

Lastly, I want to thank each person who came out for our Corpus Christi celebration of the procession and supper in the back year of the rectory. We had about 140 who attended (up from 115 the year before). The Knights and PCCW did an excellent job with the meal and sets up, serving and breaking down. It was a smooth operation and allowed our dear parishioners to enjoy each other's company. Thank you, Lord, for the beautiful weather once again.
