Assistant Pastor’s Corner

Dear St Mary’s parishioners,
I hope your summer is going well. Things are in motion here. Fr. Beardslee and I went to breakfast at the Butler Co Fair and to see the displays and animals. We have had several funerals lately in the past two weeks which have kept us busy: Doug Jones, Yvonne Gratz, Jerry Klenda and Bob Palik. We continue to pray for them and their families.
I have been up in the north tower of our Church with the Vasa construction crew. It is complex repair work they are doing. Much of the wood (115 years old) rotted out and some of the mortars on the bricks were not stable anymore. They have constructed a new floor up high to work from and are working to replace a lot of wood, bricks, and mortar. Obviously, the tower is high and heavy so they can only do one corner at a time and while they stabilize the other three corners. Pray for them to remain safe as they do this work.
This is a big wedding month in my life. I know five couples are getting married and going to three weddings. Tomorrow, I will return to NAM for my first wedding since leaving. On Friday, I will be in Chicago for my nephew’s wedding at St Micheals. This is my brother Kevin and Anne’s eldest and first of five to be wed. I enjoy weddings, especially with family and when I know the people well. It is an exciting time for all. I am blessed to save \$800 on two nights in a hotel by staying with some friends 30 minutes away.

I have just concluded hosting the International Priests Tennis Tournament in KC. 20/26 players stayed at host families. The love for the priesthood, game of tennis, travel, our Faith and making new memories united us. We had a lot of tennis matches with my brother serving as the tournament director. No serious injuries. One priest, who was a former champion in Lincoln, who came from Canada, needed to fly home to the Philip-pines to be with his mother who then died on Wednesday. His departure allowed me to reach the finals where I was crushed by a 45-year-old former college player from Arkansas. Everyone had fun, good sportsmanship and spoke highly of the event, the tour of KC and three dinners that my brothers and their wives hosted. We had nice Masses at Redemptorist and Cure of Ars in Leawood.
Several months ago, I was stressing about the numbers and details that I needed to manage. I gave it all to the Blessed Virgin Mary and she took it and made everything work out. We had a couple issues, but it was much better than I could have imagined due to God’s help and Mary’s intercession. I am relieved it is over and was such a success.
