Friday night Fr. Schukei and I attended the Annual Pro-Life Banquet in Lincoln. I always find the evening to be inspirational and I looked forward to sitting at a table from St. Mary.

This weekend is my State of the Parish address. I hope that you enjoy seeing the year in review and hearing about our many St. Mary Parish accomplishments. While we struggle to raise enough money to pay our bills, there are many good things going on. I want to celebrate and thank God for the blessings that we have experienced in the last year. I know that some people are coming back to church, who have been away. This is the best news that I can tell you. We have many more we need to pray will come back to Jesus.

Next week, you will receive a mailing about Stewardship. I have a cover letter, a Stewardship brochure, and a summary of our financial situation. This week we had to borrow \$40,000 from our restoration/building fund account to pay our bills. We ended our fiscal year with minus \$15,000 in our checking account and were \$62,696 in the red last year. Granted we did not budget to pay \$100,000 in our loan to the Bishop. We also had a couple of other areas where we failed to budget. This year's budget should be more accurate. We need some things to fall into

On January 7, 2022, St. Mary's received a check for \$119,594 from the estate of Lorray Smith. At about the same time, we were blessed to receive a check from the estate of Mary Ann Hotovy for about \$60,000. These two gifts allowed us to cash flow in the 21-22 and the 22-23 fiscal years. While in better times, St. Mary's could have put this money in the St. Mary's Endowment and not had to use it for operations. The reality is that now we have used up that cushion and are back in borrowing times and struggling. God willing, we may receive some major gifts in the fu-
