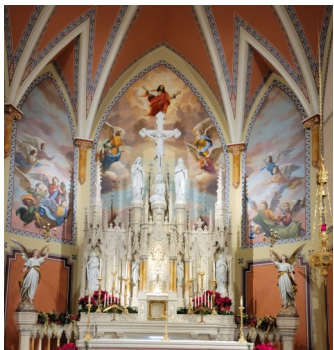

Pastor's Corner

Dear Parishioners,

The Parish Variety Show at Aquinas was fun and very well attended. I did not know what or who to expect.
