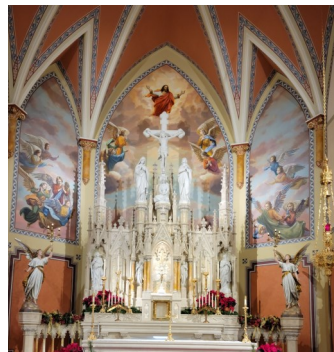

Sunday was a beautiful day for our picnic in the park. Thanks to all who attended and especially to the Fun-Raising group for hosting the day. The cookout with burgers and sausages was excellent. I enjoyed playing corn hole and cribbage. The music by Joe Cockson was also very enjoyable. What a wholesome way to spend the afternoon with fellow parishioners.
