

Assistant Pastor's Corner

Dear Parishioners:

Memorial Day Weekend has come and gone. Which means that there is no doubt that we are in the swing of summer! From spring into these early summer days there comes a great sense of newness of life. Certainly, we see this in the vegetation as things have come out of dormancy, grown, and are blooming. We have great hopes for how our landscapes and gardens will turn out...before the reality of the scorching summer heat, mildew, or pests tamper those hopes for a beautiful and fruitful season. Regardless of our capabilities and how successful we are this season in our horticultural efforts, I think our eagerness and hopes of what could be reflects something about you and I.

In the second chapter of Genesis we hear, "The LORD God planted a garden in Eden, in the east, and placed there the man whom he had formed...to cultivate and care for it." Maybe it is because of the good deal of time working outside the Church as of late, but I feel like I share this vocation of Adam...to be a gardener. Adam really is the "first gardener." Essentially, what is a gardener? A gardener is one who has dominion over a specific piece of land with the responsibility of caring for it. A good gardener creates an environment in which his plants are able to grow abundantly and be fruitful.

The beauty of spring/early summer is that it doesn't matter how fruitful your garden was last year or the year before, it is a new year with a new start. May these early summer days be an opportunity to get a fresh start at your spiritual gardening. So, what are those things that you need to cultivate in your spiritual garden? Identify them and let's get to work, fulfilling our call to cultivate and care for our spiritual lives!
