Pastor's Corner

Dear Parishioners:

Henry Doorly Zoo trip is this coming Friday, July 7. You can still sign up your children and a chaperone if you want. Currently, we only have six coming.

The landscaping project continues to take shape. RJ Hein and his daughter were a huge help with his chain saw and tractor pulling helping us pull out the large 50 year old shrubs on the SW corner of the Church. Someone mentioned Kobza Motors and their wrecker. Tim Beaver was kind enough to come up and pull out all the root by attaching a couple large chains to his hydraulic winch and successfully extraditing them. Thanks Tim!

Plants are getting put in place by Fr. Schukei. Mulch was delivered by Chuck Oborny and some spread. Of course, we have been blessed with several welcome rains that have happily suspended work. May God continue to give us timely and substantial rainfall for our crops. Hopefully, we will complete the project before too long.

I want to thank Dr. Jo Witter for her wonderful talk at our Called to Holiness last Sunday. We are glad to have Deacon Jonah Brox lined up for the next one on July 23.

June 30 is the end of our fiscal year. We were blessed with a very good collection last week so we ended about \$33 K in the black, (Collection wise) thanks to your generosity. St. Mary's, after all our bills are paid, will be \$39K in the red. This is not bad, considering we paid off \$100K to the Diocese on our loan this year and that was not budgeted. To cover our expenses, we have withdrawn everything in our savings from the diocese (\$11,063). Also, the Fundraising committee approved to pay for \$12,500 in rectory and Didier Room improvement expenses. We are very grateful for their good stewardship and support. As you know, they've held two major fundraisers; the Garage sale and Variety Show. Those events earned about \$10K and 6K respectively. They also given an additional \$2,500 to Hope for the Poor. With these two sources, we are about \$13K short so we will probably have our Restoration of the Church fund help us cash flow through the shortfall.

Overall, we seem to have had a good year thanks to the generosity and good stewardship of our parishioners. It takes a lot of tithing, donations, volunteering, and things going right for us to cash flow. In this respect, we have a very vibrant and growing parish. God willing, more people will get involved in the year ahead. Recently, I am encouraged that our Charity and Stewardship Appeal (CSA) reached the goal this past week with a significant 205 donors. We passed our goal by \$100!

We still owe the diocese \$80,000 which I hope we can pay off in the coming year. We also still owe Aquinas \$270,000 from the past decade and will need to address that in the months ahead. Our Finance committee will meet in July to help plan the new budget year. I am trying to be transparent and informative with you so that we can have more ownership with our parishioners. Our Parish Council meets on July 10 and our Stewardship Committee on July 12. They are also informed on our financial situation and many other important faith and community related events.

I am very excited to have my first wedding this weekend at St. Mary's in 15 years. I also started another wedding prep last weekend. I think most all priests enjoy preparing couples for marriage and witnessing their vows.

Unfortunately, many people are not getting sacramental marriages these days. It would make their weddings become even more special. God bless all our married couples. **FBC**
