Pastor’s Corner

Dear St. Mary / Assumption Parishioners,

Summertime is a chance to do things we do not normally have time for. The past couple of weeks I have toured three places I have wanted to see for over a year.

This week I had a nice visit to the Bone Creek Agrarian Museum downtown in David City. The main exhibit on loan from an artist in Wisconsin was incredibly beautiful and well described. The back room had some exceptionally large and beautiful paintings. Everyone is excited about the new, large location that will open within a year.

This week I traveled to Hastings with another priest for the rededication of their newly renovated High and Middle school. It was also a farewell for Fr. Tom Brouillette who has been their CAO since 2011. The building looks improved with the new space and the chapel is especially gorgeous. The chapel is out front and nicely integrated into the existing space. The program, in spite of, sitting in the 98-degree sun, was very inspiring. I saw lots of people whom I remember from my time there in 91-93. I was reminded, that some of the best people attend events like dedications.

The previous week, I stopped in at York College to see the Clayton Museum of Ancient History. It focused on the Biblical history, Jewish, Greek, Roman and early Medieval times. They have lots of artifacts and excellent chronological arrangements of the most influential people over the 5-millennial period. You need at least 90 minutes to two hours to take it all in.

I had some nice conversations on the street this week as I walked throughout the town. People are very friendly, and it is easy to strike up conversations.

We plan to offer ALPHA at St. Mary’s Didier room on Tuesday at 6 p.m. on Sept 10 for 11 weeks. It includes a healthy dinner for 30 minutes, a video for 30 minutes and discussion for 45 minutes. It is for anyone, Catholic, Christian, non-Baptized, young, and old. Their website is <https://alpha.org/about/> The first few topics are: Is there more to life than this? Who is Jesus? Why did Jesus die? How can I have faith? Why and how do I pray? Why and how should I read the Bible? After week seven, we will have a retreat on Oct 26, Saturday at either OLGC Retreat House (Waverly) or at Benedictine Retreat Center (Schuyler). This retreat focuses on the Holy Spirit.
