Pastor’s Corner

Dear St. Mary / Assumption Parishioners,

We completed Totus Tuus this past week and had 92 students attend, 1st-12th grade. I thought the team did an outstanding job and they complemented the students. They focused on the Glorious Mysteries and the Nicene Creed this year. Thanks to all the High School aged students who gave of their time to help out. Thanks to the host families and all who brought lunches for the team. Thanks to the snack and lunch supervisors. It takes a lot of people to have a successful week and you made it possible. Thanks to Sr. Mary, Heather and Fr. Schukei for your commitment also.

After Masses this weekend, we will again have people collecting signatures for the Pro-life ballot initiative. Thanks to all those have helped to collect signatures.

Next week chess camp is on Monday, Wednesday and Thursday from 10-noon in the Didier Room. Any age is welcome to attend including adults too if you want to learn the amazing game of chess. We can circle back to the basics and go from there. \$10 per day and it all goes to Hope of the Poor.

I enjoyed learning more about the introductory year to the seminary this week. It is called the propaedeutic year and prepares men to become a seminarian. The Priestly formation guidelines have called for this change which is taking place all over the world. During the past year held at St. Gregory the Great seminary in Seward, the men read a lot of classic books. They read the entire Bible and are taught to pray and meditate. They prepare for and learn about human, spiritual, intellectual and pastoral formation. They fast from media and technology including computers (tablets, phones) except for Saturdays for a couple hours. They had a chance to travel to Mexico City with Hope of the Poor and experience a poverty immersion. Additionally, they traveled to Rome and Italy for 10 days. They have daily Mass, prayer time and the sacraments, and have had classes with some excellent professors at SGG. Personally, I would think that any parent would love to have a son experience this good formation. Surely, if a young man does a propaedeutic year, he will only become a better person afterwards. I am glad to hear that sixteen will enter this preparatory year in August. Please keep them in your prayers.

This coming week I will attend two priestly 25th celebrations (Seward and KCKS). It is a big milestone and worth celebrating. Generally, it represents the first half of your priesthood and you can see the second half coming. I look forward to both celebrations.
