Perpetual Adoration Note: Please note that, as is the long-standing tradition in the Church, exposition of the Blessed Sacrament for perpetual adoration will be suspended from Midnight (12:00 am) on Holy Thursday night (Good Friday morning) until 10:00 pm on Holy Saturday night (following the Easter Vigil Mass). Jesus in the Blessed Sacrament will still be present in the tabernacle in St. Joseph Adoration Chapel. The chapel doors will remain open and the lights will remain on! Adorers are NOT required to fulfill their obligations during those hours but all are welcome to come and pray before our Lord in the tabernacle at any time.


